GENERAL EDUCATION (GNED)

GNED 3210 Credits: 3

Multiculturalism in Business Total Hours: 45

This course prepares students in the development of foundational concepts of financial management in the hospitality industry. This enables them to understand how corporations make important investment and financing decisions and how they establish working capital policies. This course is taught using the standards of the Hospitality Financial and Technology Professionals (HFTP). This course is part of the full-time Bachelor of Hospitality Management program. GNED 4260 Credits: 3

Sustainability in Business Total Hours: 45

This course provides students opportunities to analyze current environmental changes and the ways in which people and the planet interact.
